To be a leader in post-academic orthopedic education and outreach, and to provide treatment for pediatric and adult lower extremity deformities in communities where it is most needed.




### **CLESF Courses**

CLESF courses bring together leading podiatric, orthopedic, orthoplastic, and microsurgical experts to explore and discuss innovations in lower extremity practice and techniques. The **Chicago Lower Extremity Surgical Foundation** courses are planned and implemented in accordance with the **Essential Areas and Policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (CME)**.

# Chicago Lower Extremity Surgical Symposium

**FOCUS:** Orthoplastic Fracture Management and The Chicago Lower Extremity Surgical Symposium (CLESS) provide a basis for current surgical techniques in orthoplastic fracture management and reconstructive peripheral nerve surgery. The course is three intense days, featuring two days of didactic lectures and one day of cadaveric skills sessions, led by some of the world's leading surgeons in these techniques. **CLESS** is designed for physicians interested in increasing their training and knowledge in internal and external fixation, orthoplastic fracture management, muscle flap techniques, plastic reconstruction, nerve repair, and associated orthobiologics applications.

**REGISTRATION:** Didactic Lectures (one day) and Lab In-Person (one day) offers one day of didactic lectures and one day of cadaver skills dissection (two dates to choose from). Participants may view sessions live and will have ability to view sessions on-line for a determined period of time post course.




#### Cless By Doctor Type\*



#### Leef By Doctor Type\*




#### Cless By Region\*\*
